Ans: Weather is the state of the atmosphere at a particular place and time as regards heat ,cloudiness, dryness, sunshine, wind, rain, etc.
 2. What is climate?
Ans: Climate is the weather conditions prevailing in an area in general or over a long period.
 3. Write any two factors that effect the climate of a place.
Ans: The two factors that effect the climate of a place are:
 - (i) Location of a place : It plays a major role in determining the climate of the place.
 - (ii) Amount of rainfall: It also determine the climate of the place.
 4. Write any two effects of climate on the life of people.
Ans: The two effects of climate on the life of people are:
 - (i) Home: People living in cold climate make houses with sloping roofs, people living in hot climate make houses with thick walls and flat roofs.
 - (ii) Dress: people living in cold climate wear woollen dresses and people living in hot climate wear light and cotton dresses.
