




	5. What are insectivorous plants ? How does a Venus fly trap catch insects? Ans: Plants that are carnivorous in nature and trap insects are called insectivorous plants. Venus flytrap has leaves that are like boxes with hinges. They have stiff hair-like structures on the inside of the leaves. When an insect touches the hair, the leaf snaps shut, trapping the creature inside.


